

AVOID PRODUCTS WITH MICROBEADS

Many scrubs, face washes and shower gels contain microbeads (tiny non-biodegradable plastic beads less than 1mm) that pollute oceans and are ingested by marine creatures. Microbeads are made of: Polyethylene (PE), Polypropylene (PP), Polyethylene terephthalate (PET), Polymethyl methacrylate (PMMA), Nylon (PA). When you shop next, avoid items with these ingredients.

GREEN SHOPPING

Many of these harmful elements can be found in items that we use daily or come wrapped in plastics that are not disposed off carefully. Step 1 - Gather the things you'll need -

(Old newspaper , a pair of scisscors , adhesive glue , Piece of cardboard , Ballpoint pen , Ropes or handles from old bags . And some decorative materials (optional) .

Step 2 - Fold your newspaper and stick it .

Step 3 . Fold the sheets horizontally from both sides and glue the edges together .

Step 4 . Insert a rectangular piece of cardboard for the base according to your bag width .

Step 5 . Add glue on all sides of cardboard base . fold the corner's in triangle and seal the paper edges .

Step 6 . Press the edges on both sides of bag and make fold in middle . This fold called accordion fold .

Step 7 Now . Make holes at the open end and cut two pieces of rope and tie . Make sure your knots are firm .

Step 8 Now , you can decorate it as you want .
